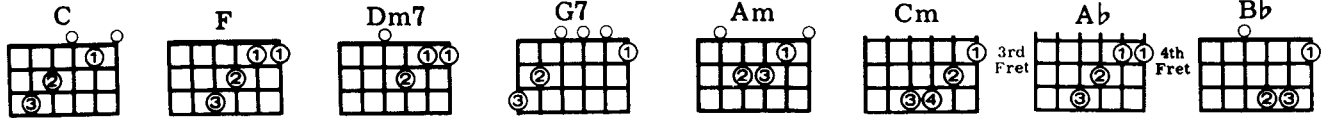


The Fool On The Hill
